

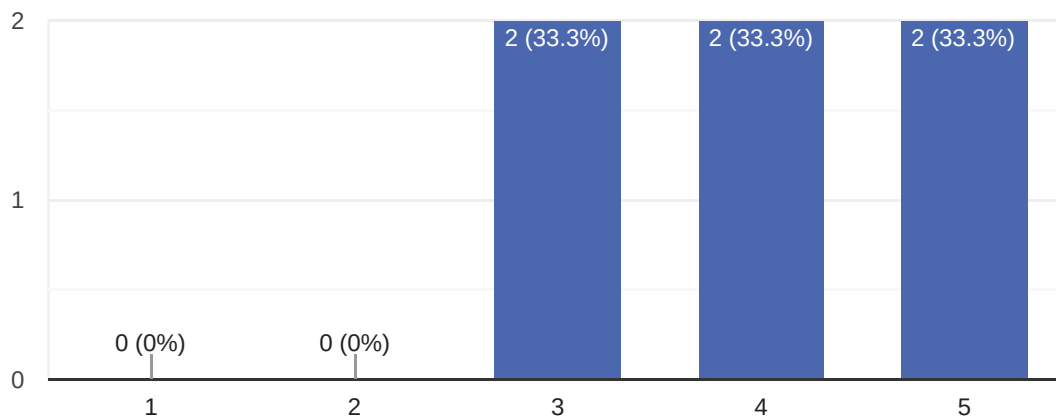

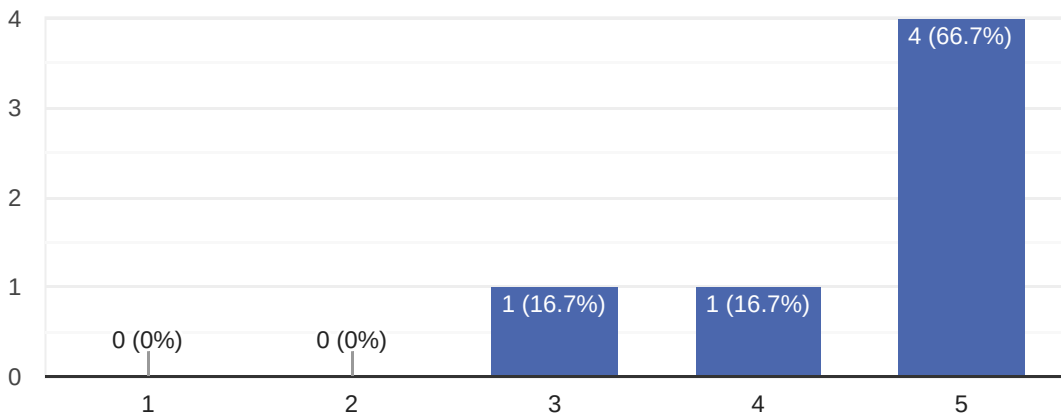

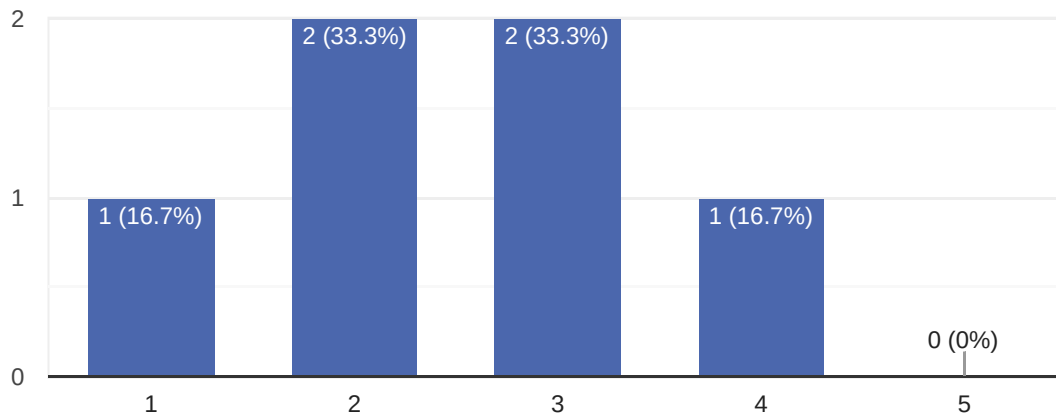

The labs are nice to have on paper. The slides not so much, those can be followed from the projector or PDF.

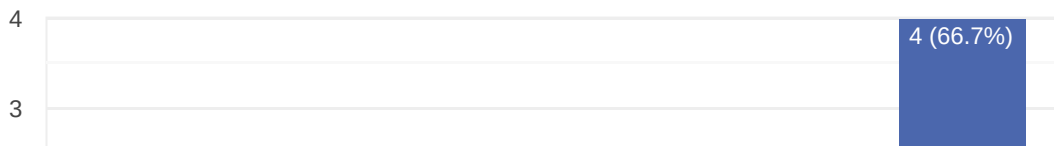
Most of the time I was reading the pdf files from my computer screen. A couple of times during the lab work it was however more convenient to check the details from the printed material.

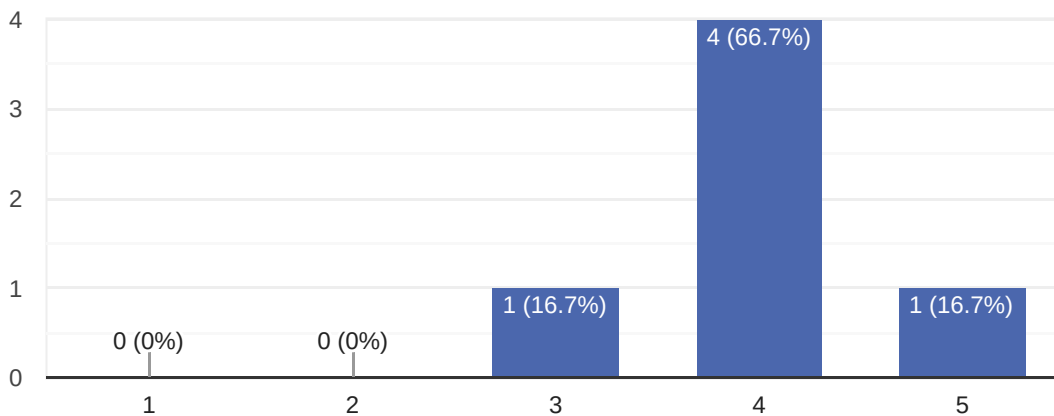

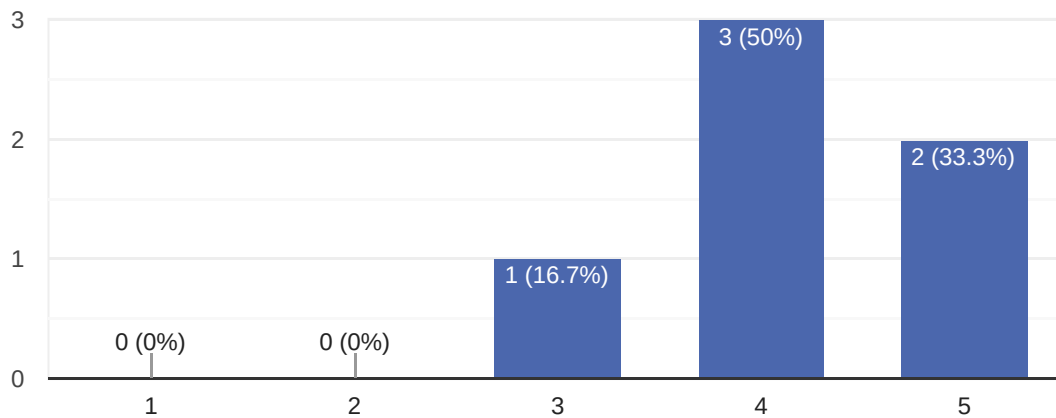
## Suggestions and comments

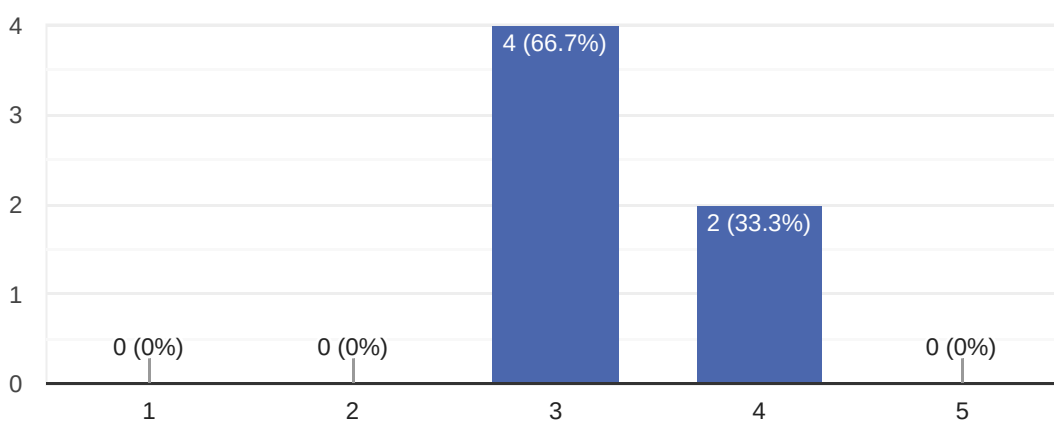

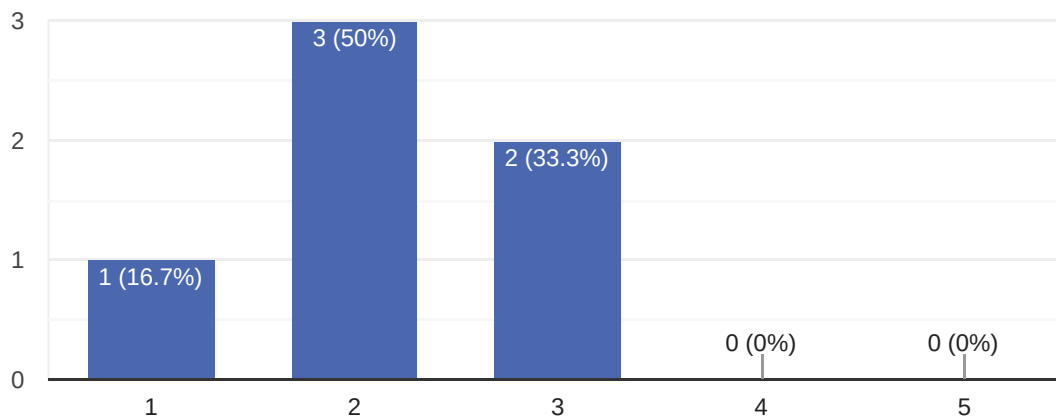

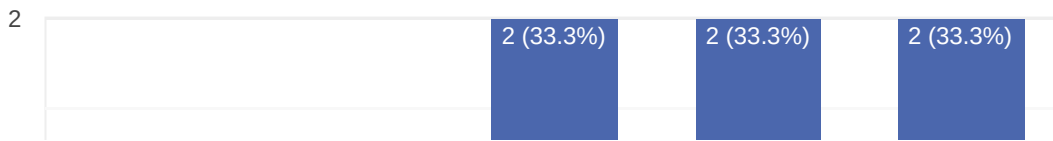

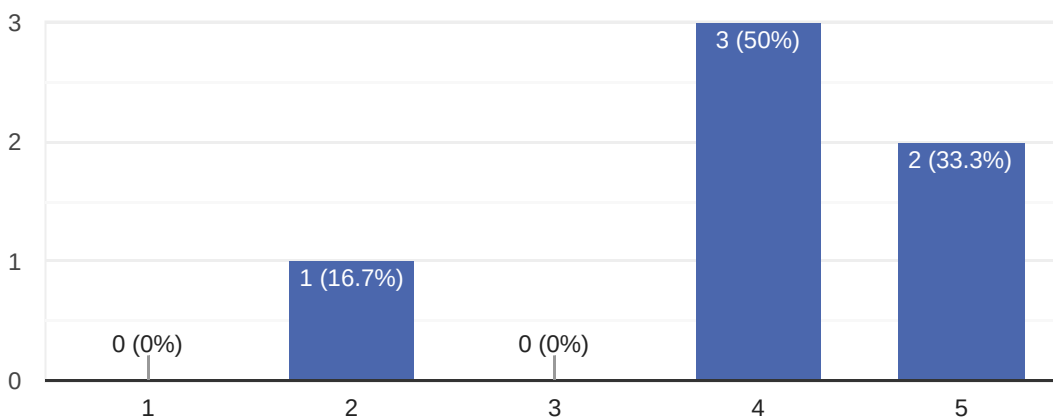

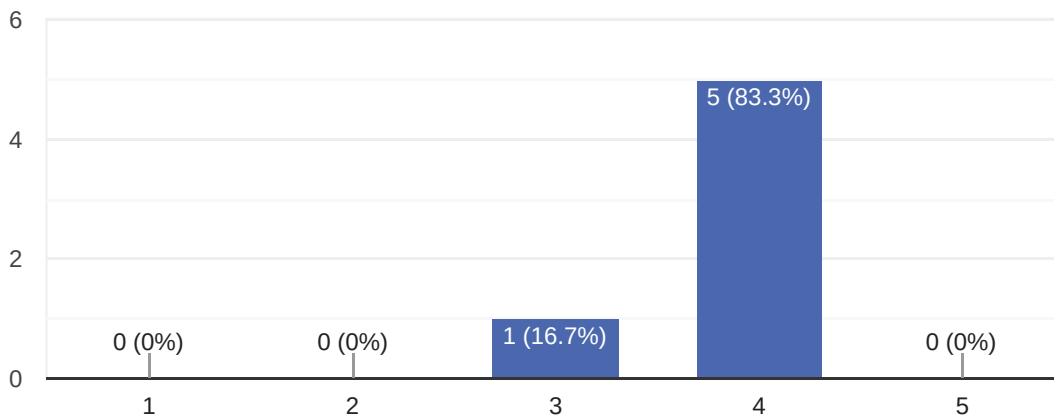

Lectures gave me a lot of details and background information on multiple topics. Just by reading the material you can not get that much education.

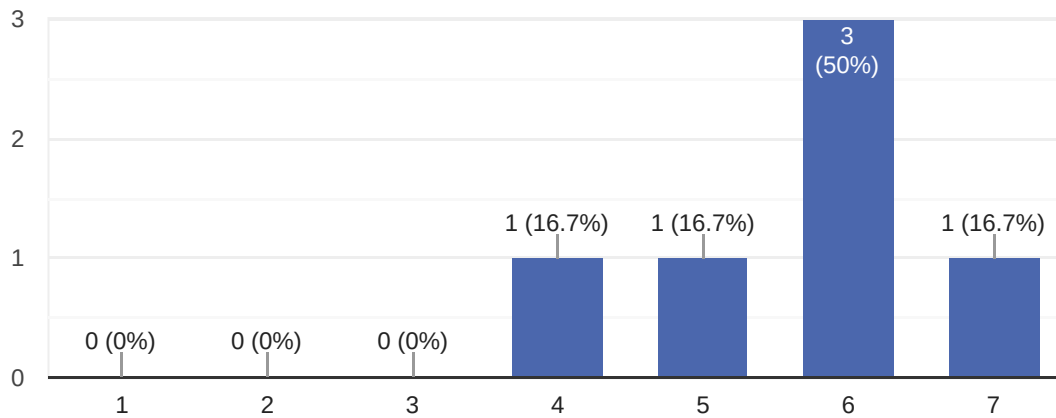
## What part(s) of the course did you like least?

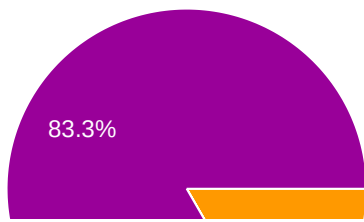
