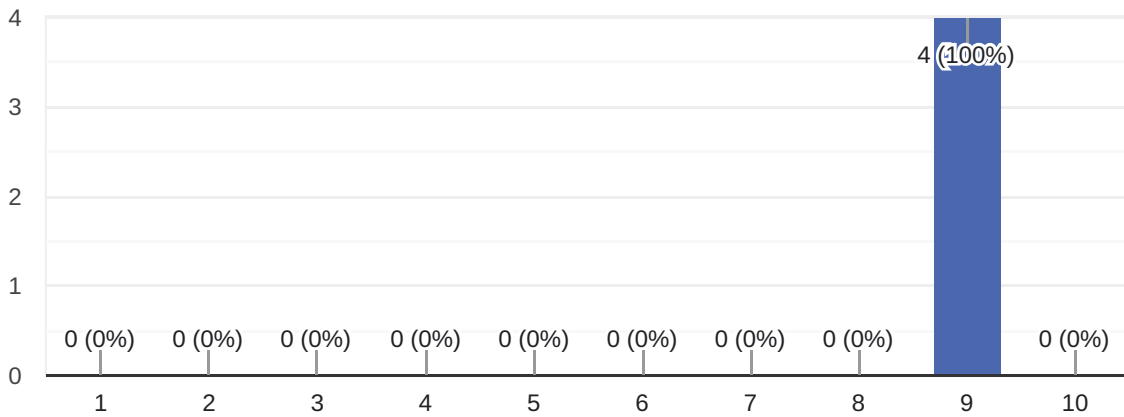

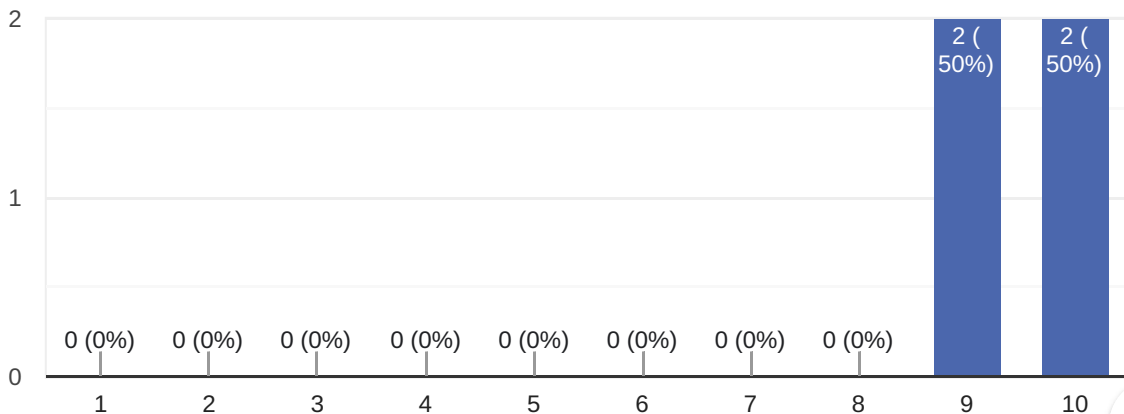

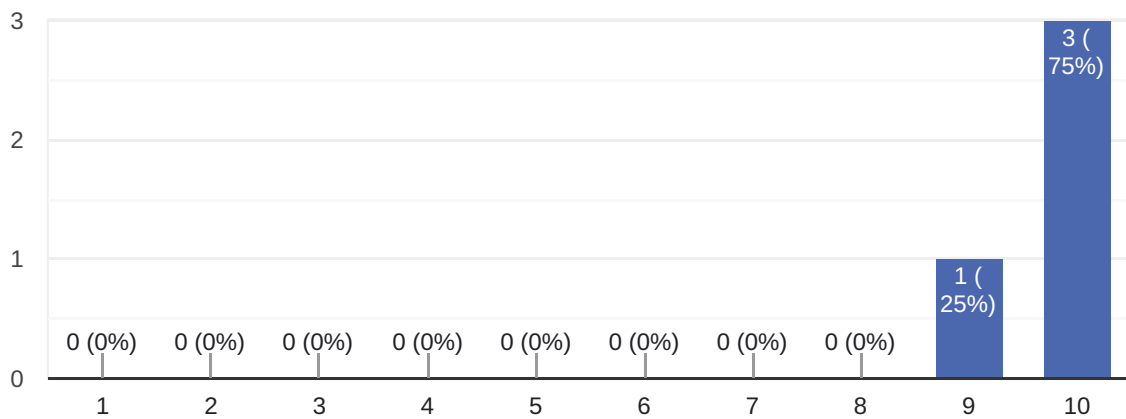
The lectures tended to be long. It might be a good idea to divide them up, have breaks or labs inbetween.
