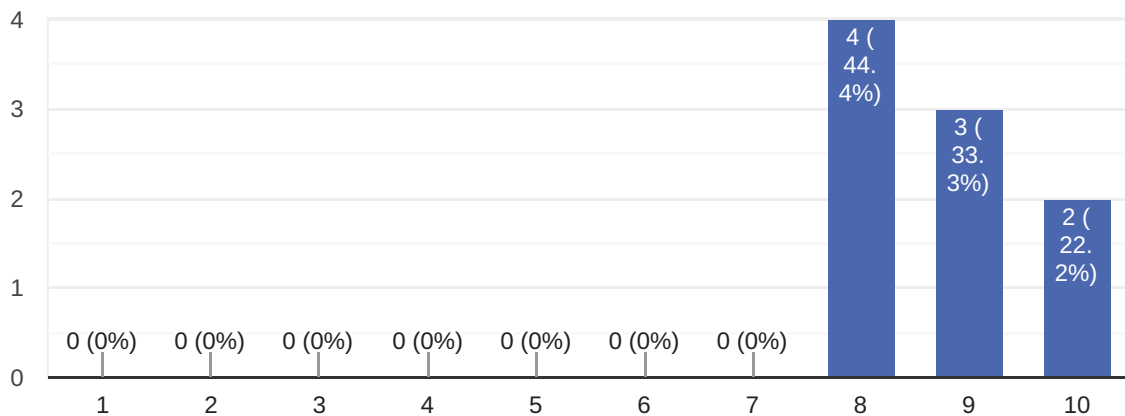

Maybe it might be a good idea to use devtool ba adding the same package (spaceinvadors) you generated by hand before so you can demonstrate that it does a good share of the handy work for you and you also could give a direct comparison of your manual generated recipe and the one from devtool. Then you can show where manual fine-tuning might be needed.

Probably not the fault of bootlin but it was a very bad idea to mix beginners and experts in a course that is not interactive.

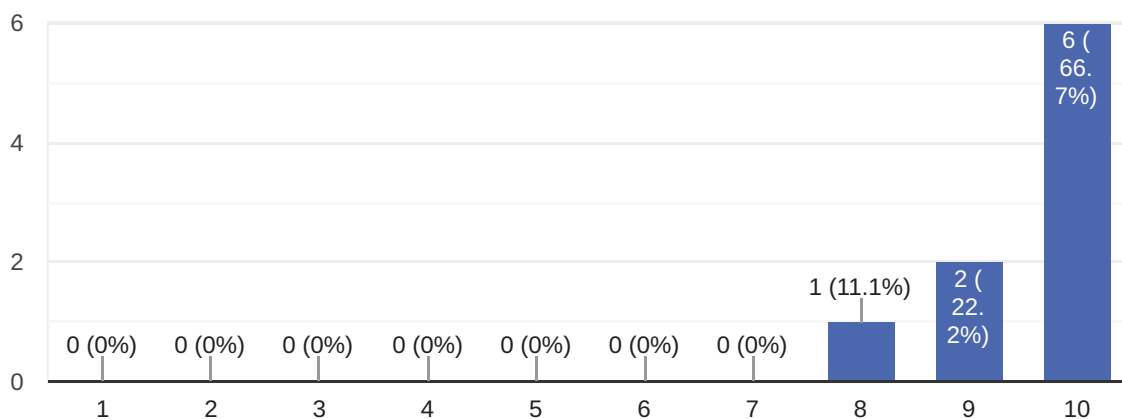
The course is well organized and I would totally recommend it for people that are new to yocto or that need a refresh

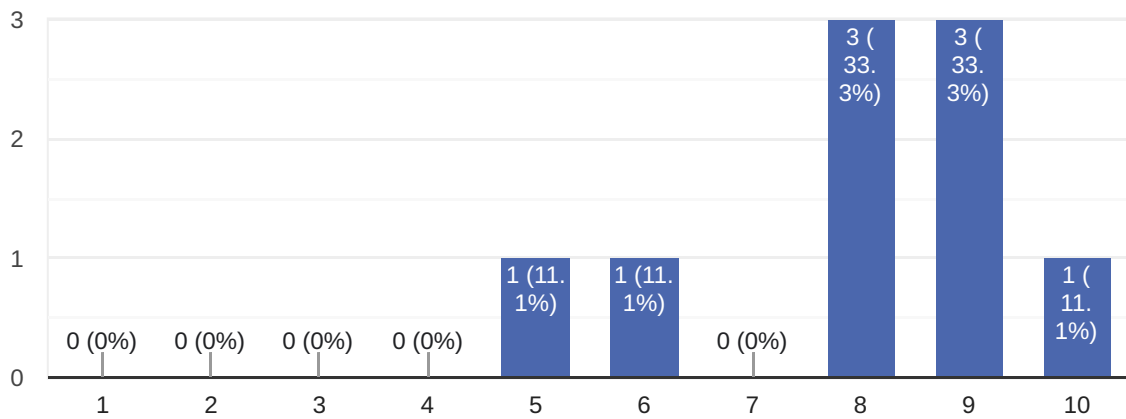

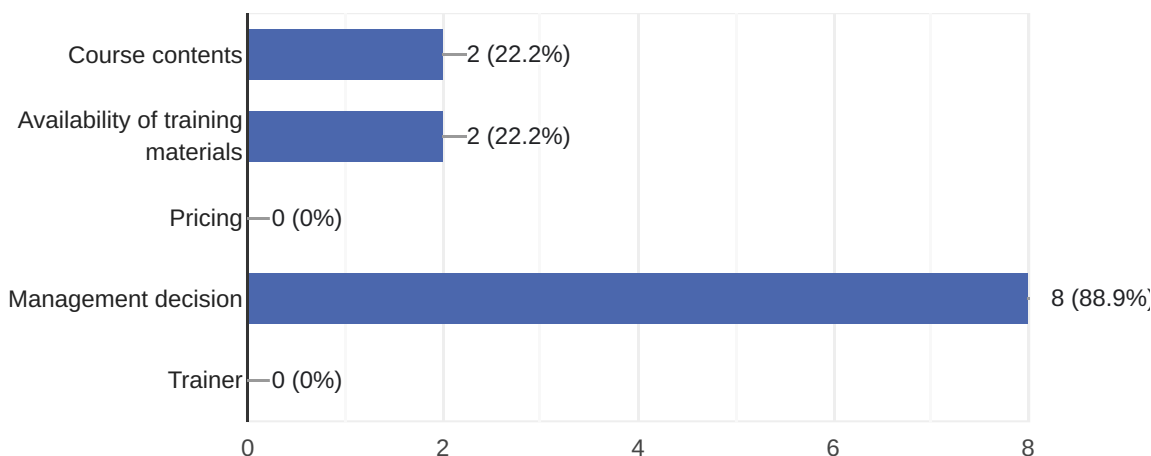
