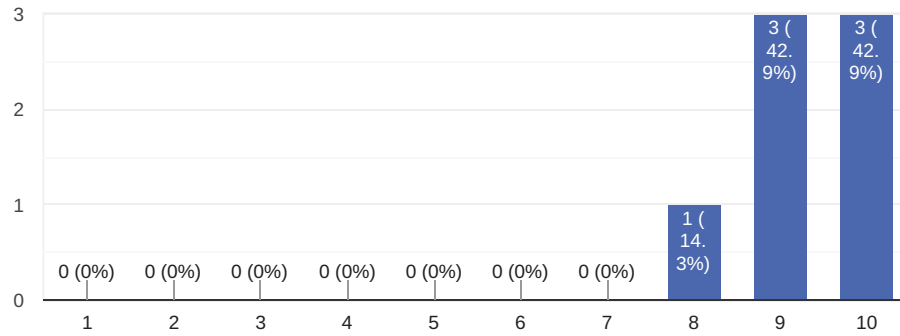

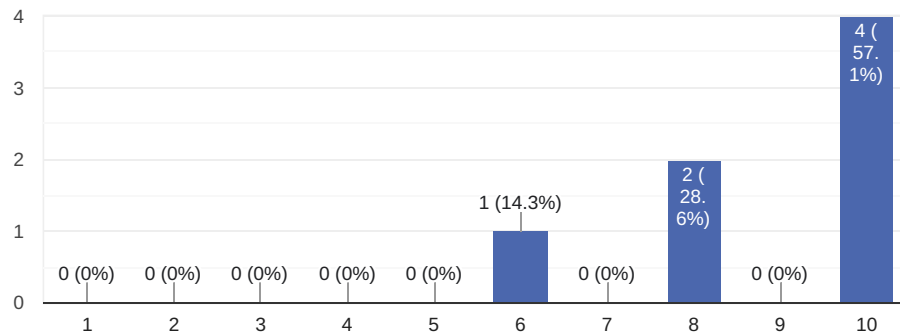
Maybe you can reduce the content because there are a lot of topics to talk this course but for beginners it is hard to handle everything.

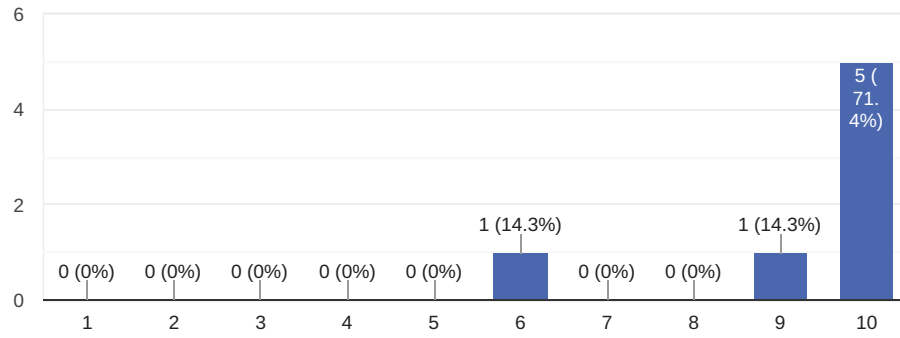
sometimes we were too fast for me to understand

Demos are useful but sometimes it is really handles fastly so I dont understand all parts.

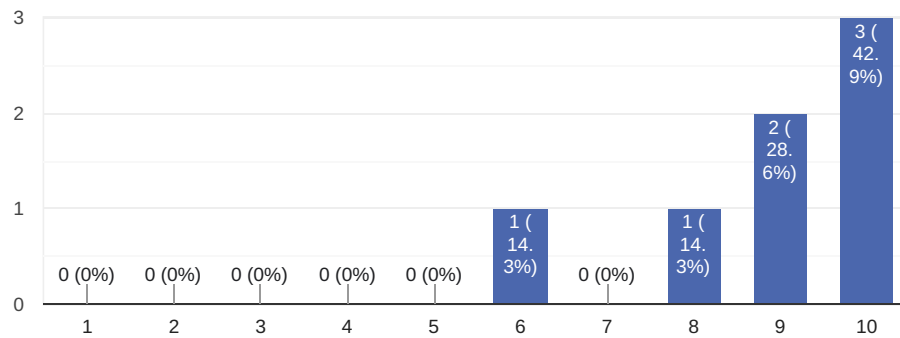
It is problematic when we do not have native Linux environment (e.g WSL2, VirtualBox).

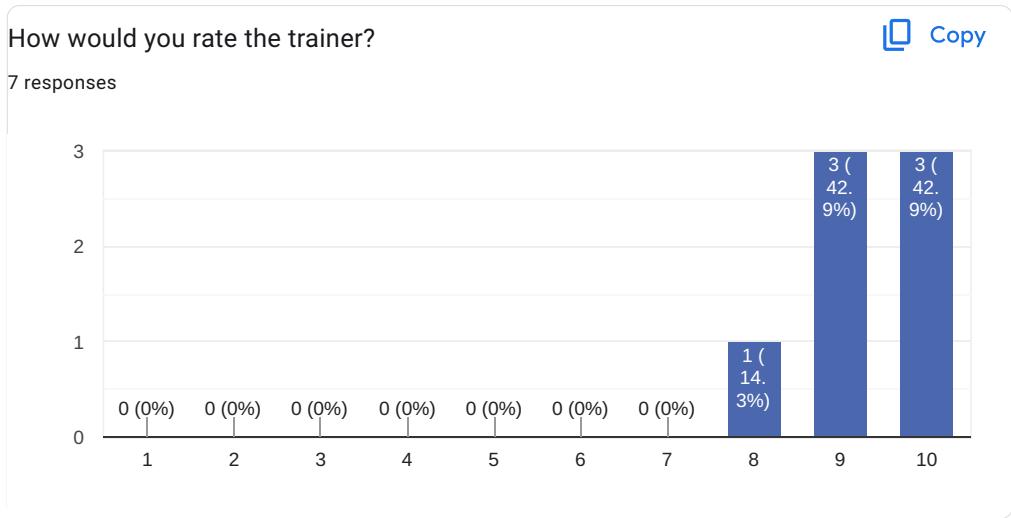

the time balance was not very good. Sometimes we had lectures that took about 90 mins and it very exhausting





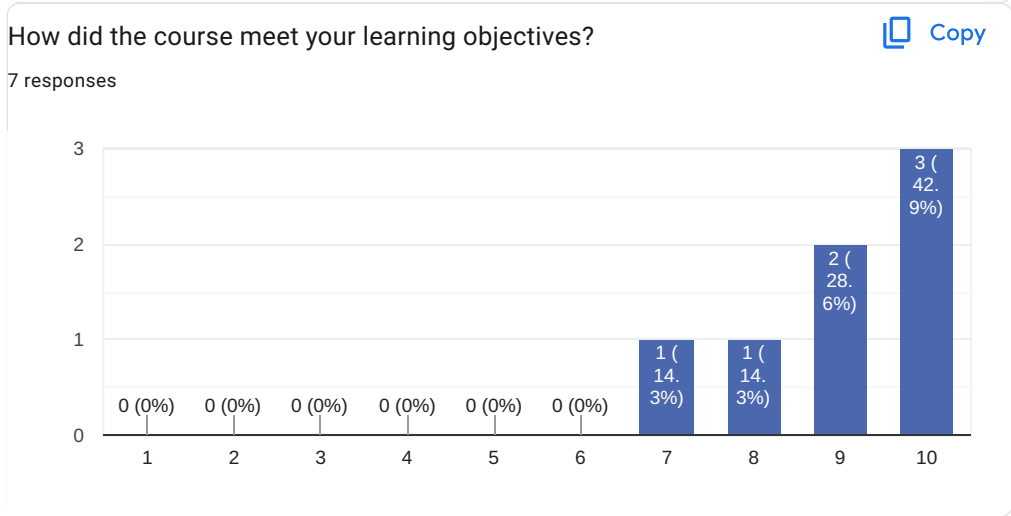

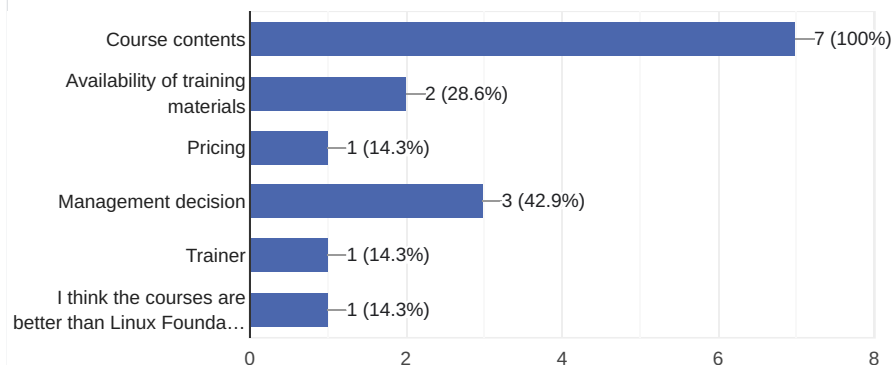
