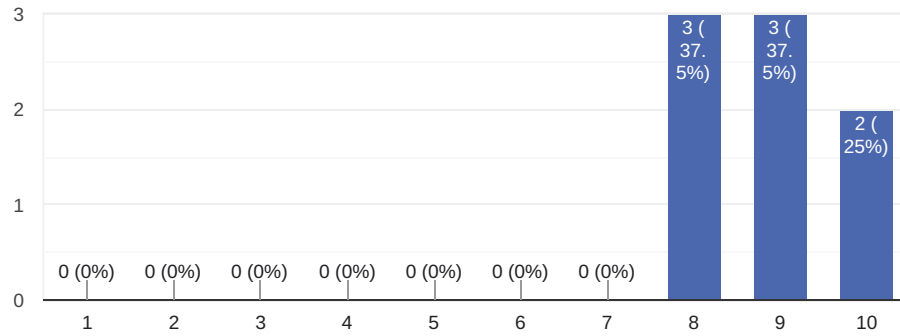

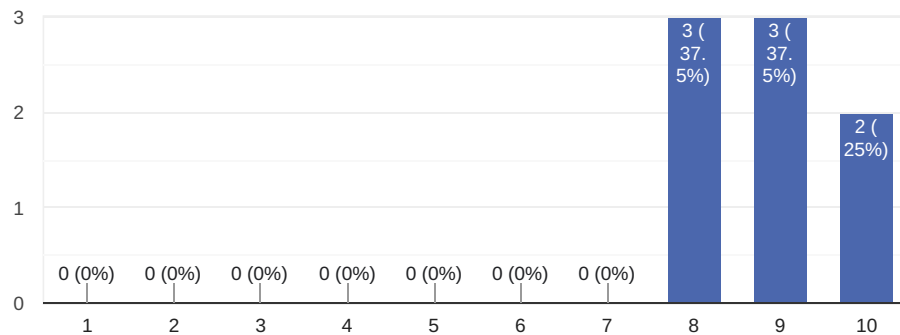

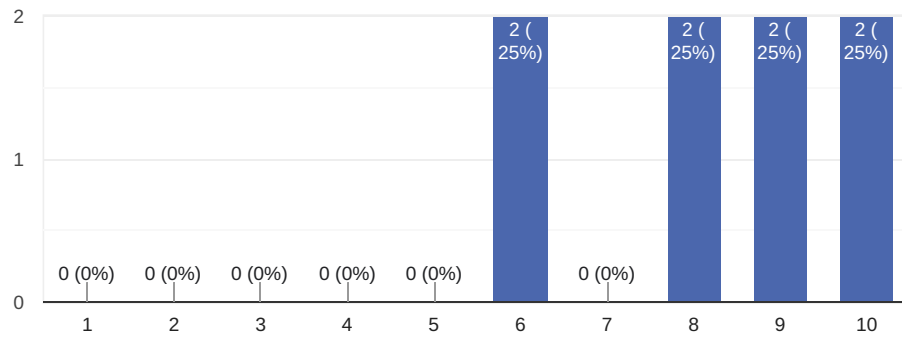

The laboratories clarify the concepts presented very well. From the most basic concepts to the concepts that will allow me to go deeper.

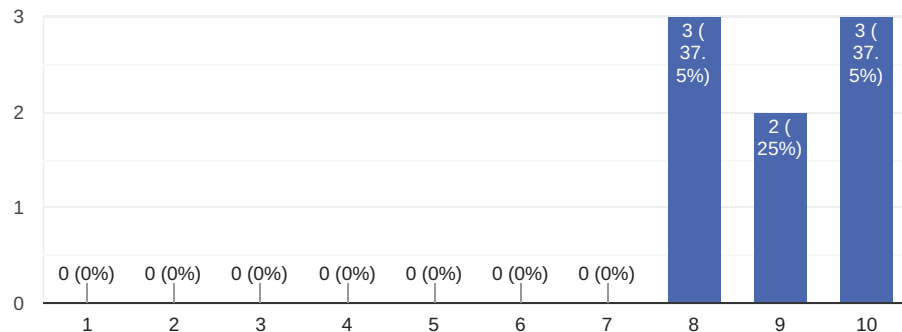
The fact of having students not to do the labs by themselves reduces knowledge capitalization.

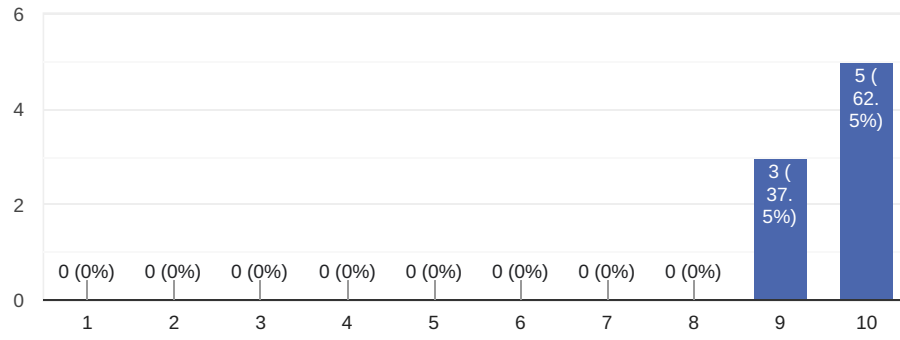

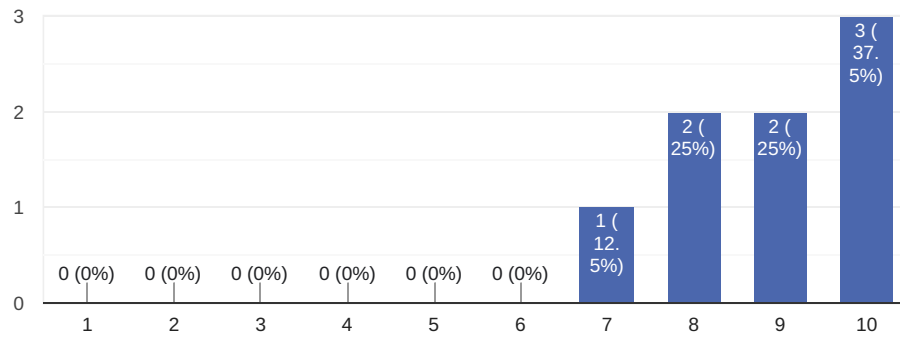

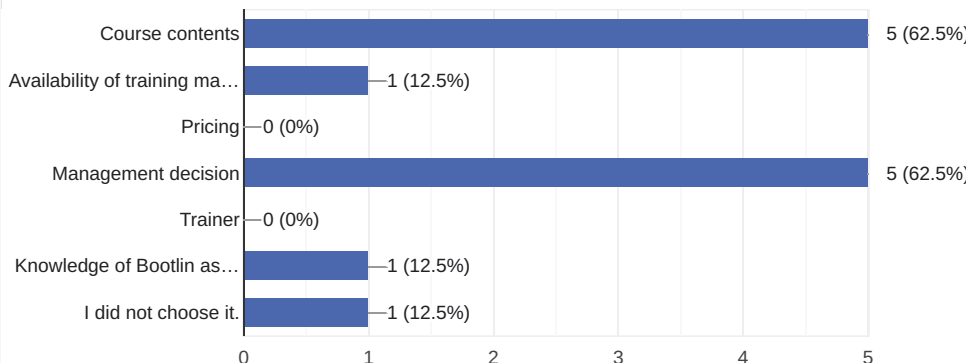
