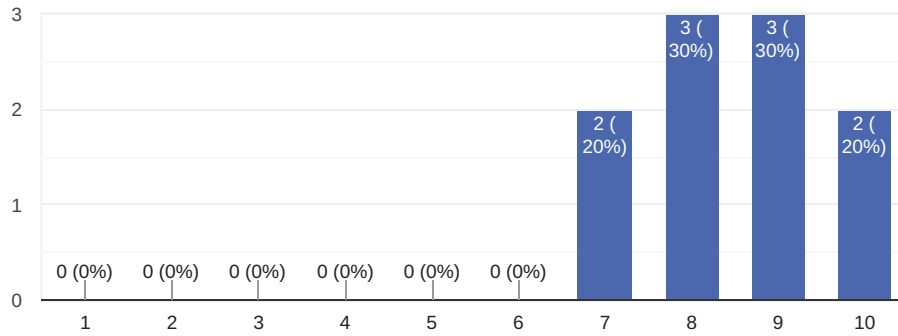

a list of prerequisites should be provided in order to eventually fill the gap before start the course

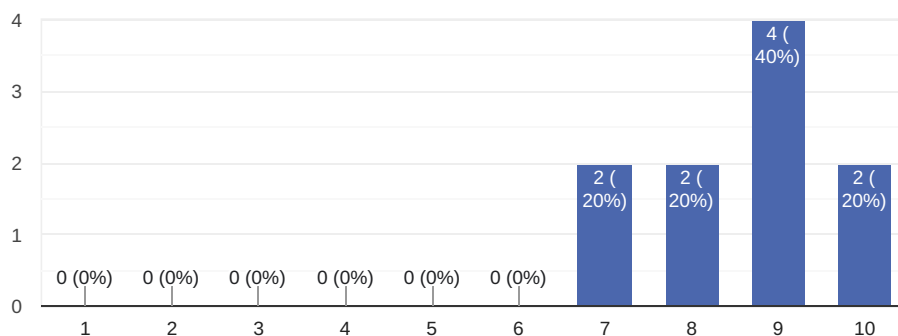
Very interesting course on an important topic.

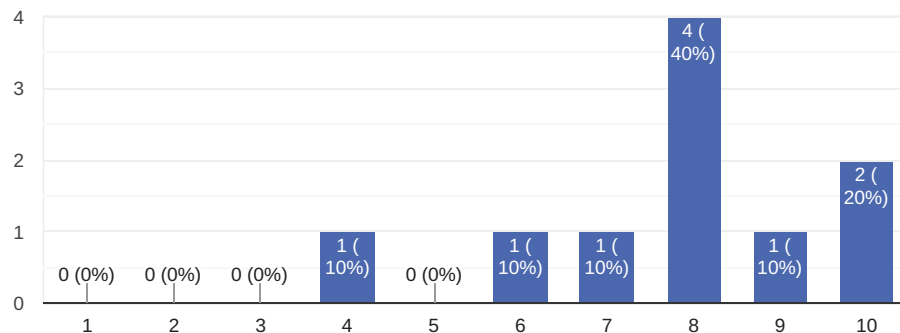
I'd not so much time to read in these days but the contents seems interesting

will be usefull to have a more interactive labs. Also maybe should be better do it slower

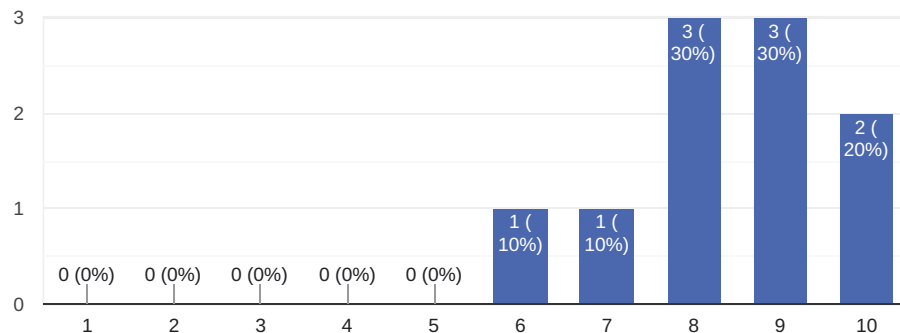

How would you rate the overall organization of the course?



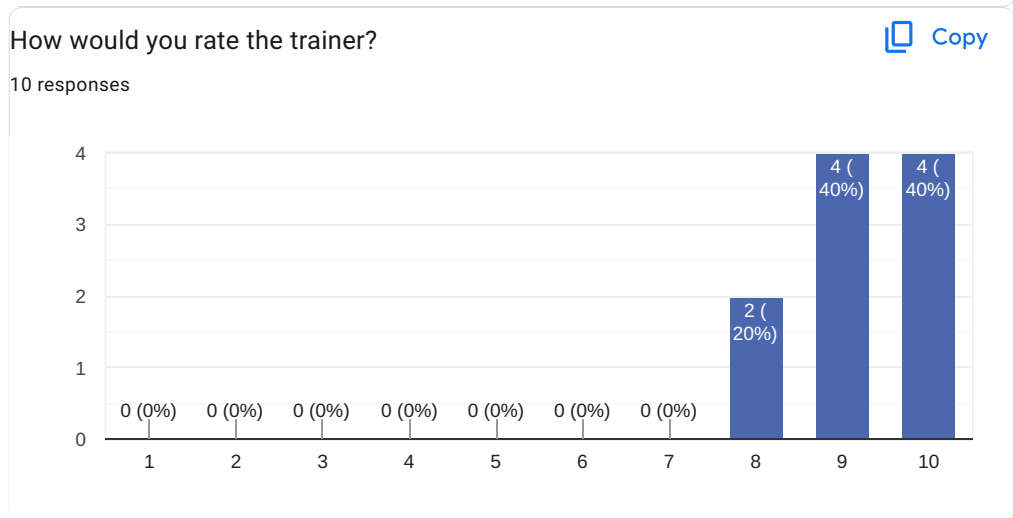

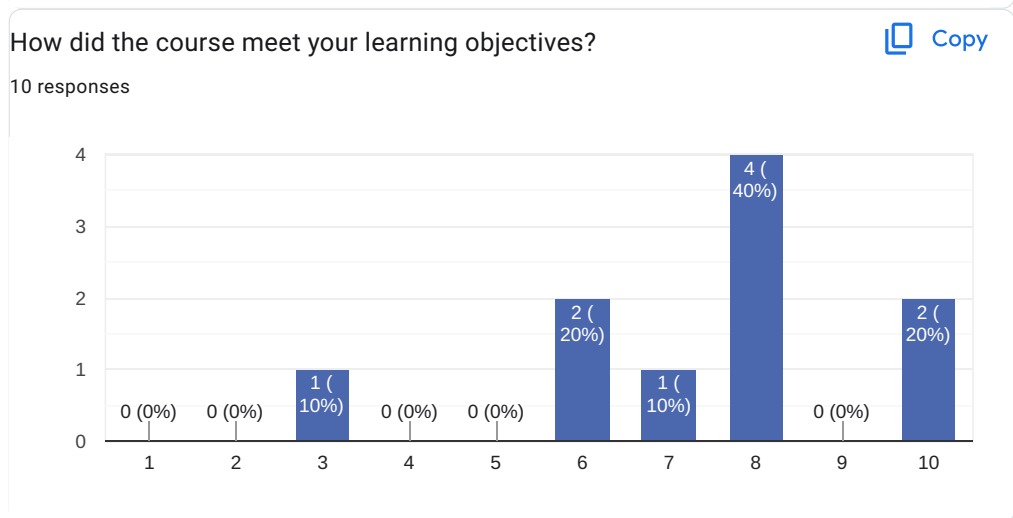

Devtool. This felt like a bonus topic that was a bit too much to take in at this stage of the course.

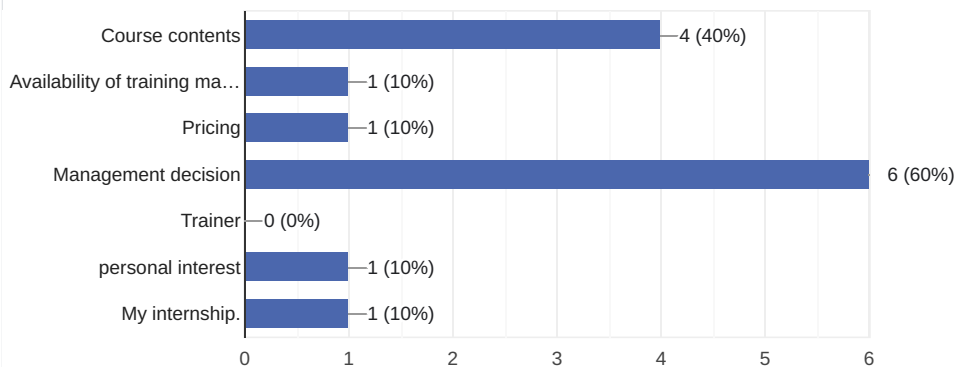
