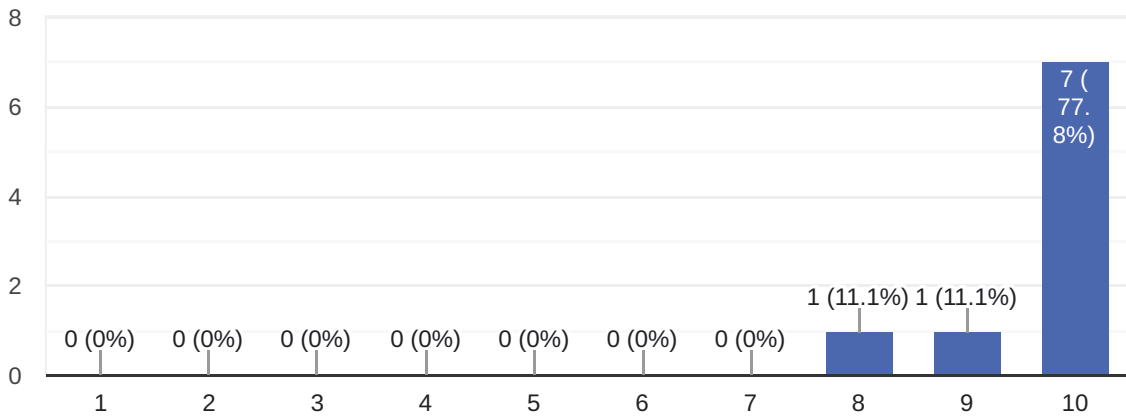

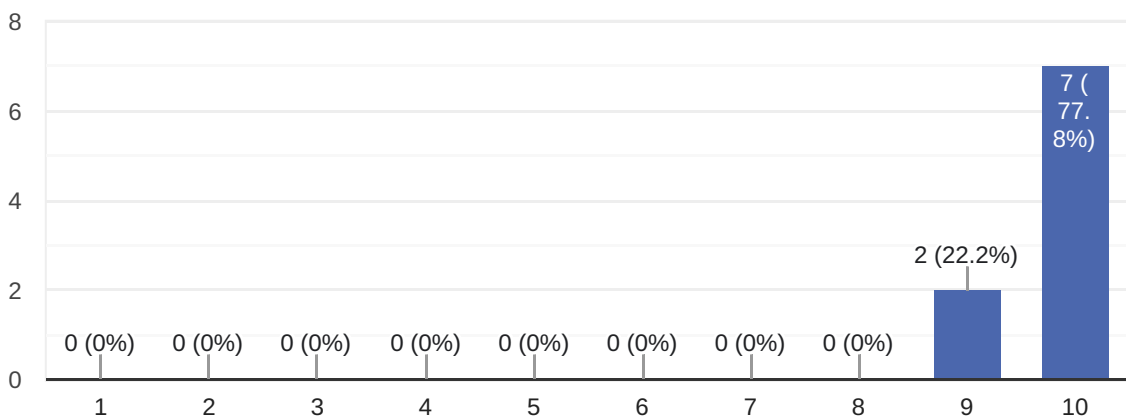

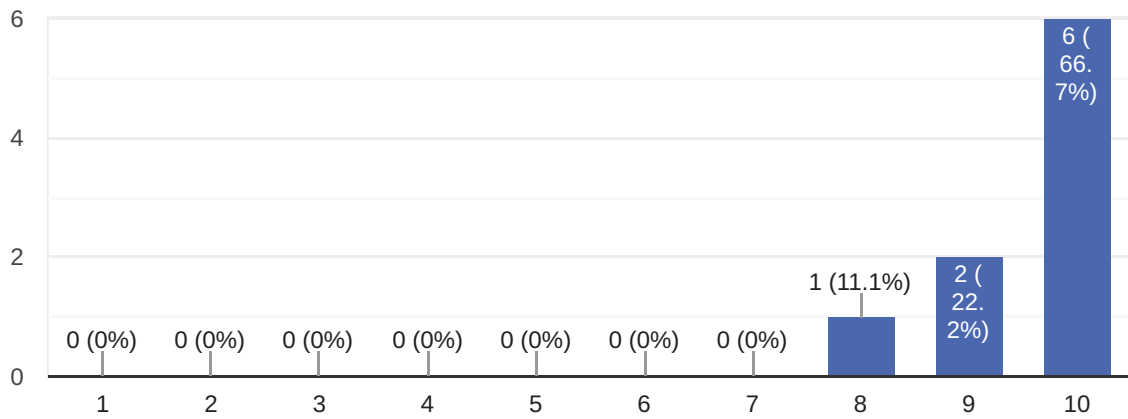
Lot of this which were added in new yocto releases, which are usefull for new features, and project improvements.

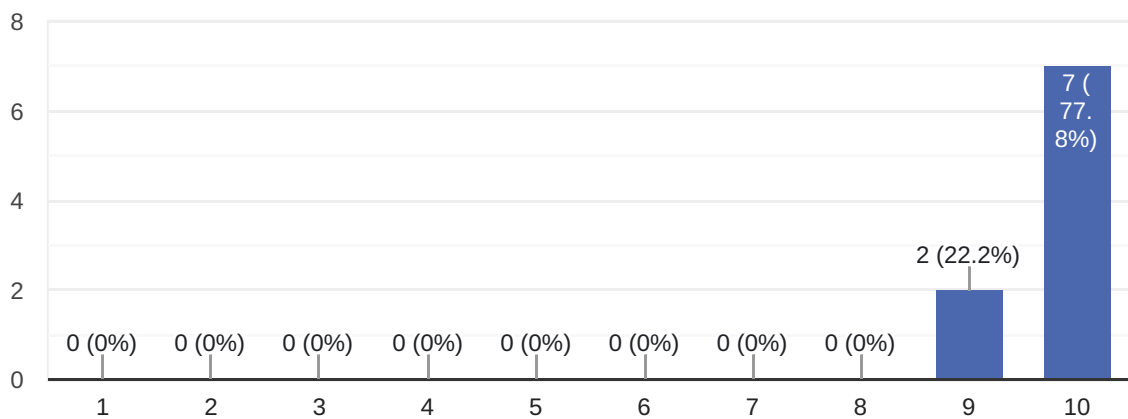

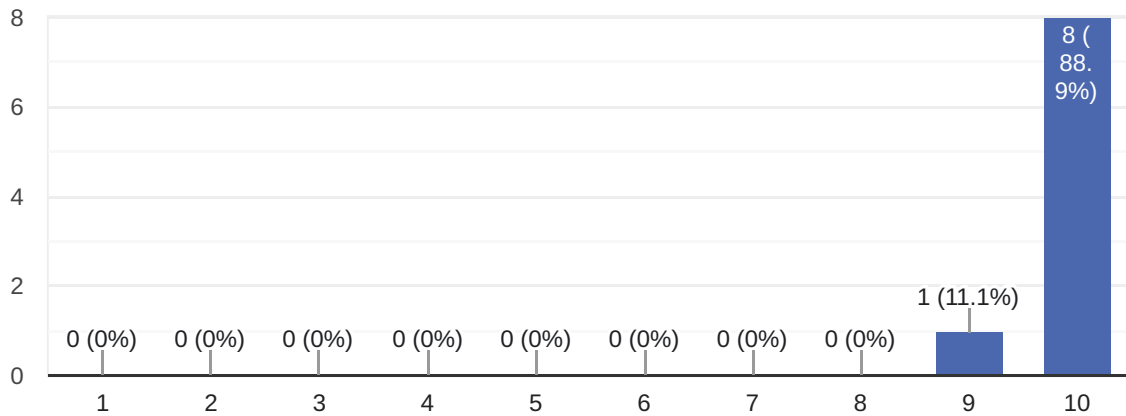

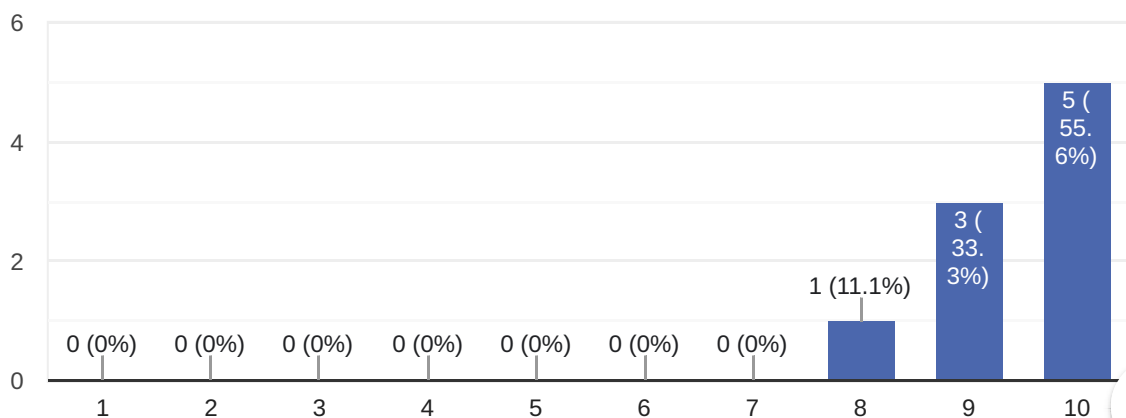
Trainer is really nice, and it seems that he has a lot experience and lot of technical expertise. Only thing which was a little issue, that with some words was hard to understand because of french accent.

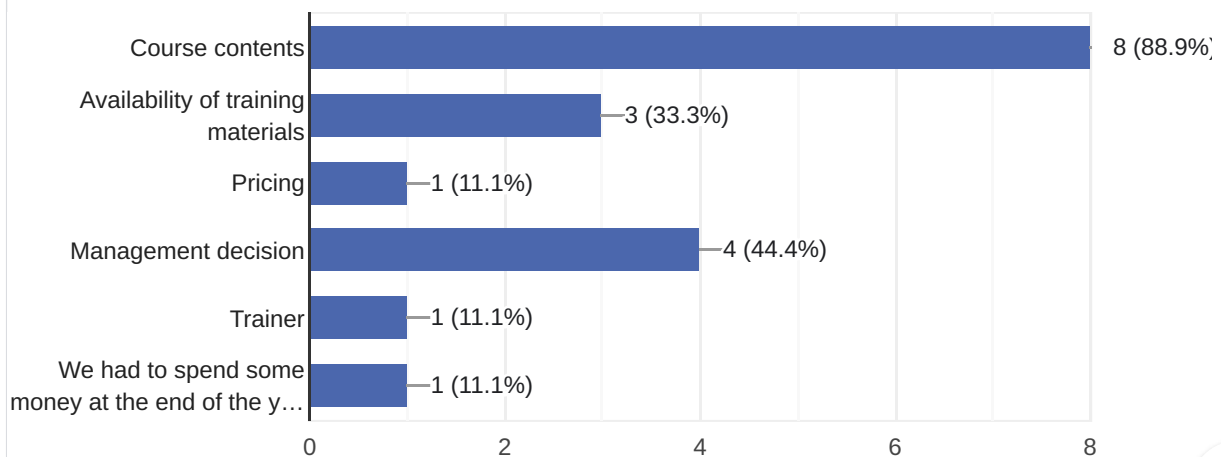
